

Kitty Kat A Story of a Cup-warmer

Materials

1 x 50g ball of a 12 ply yarn.
Little odds and ends of yarns of different colour from MC.

Tools

A pair of 4.00mm needles.
A pair of 5.5mm needles.
Needle for sewing up.

Clover Felting kit which includes:

Clover Felting Mat
Clover Felting Needles

A handle-less mug/cup/glass of your choice.



How To

Cast on 32 sts on the 4.00mm needles.

1st row: (K2, P2) till end.

2nd row: (K2, P2) till end

Change to 5.5mm needles.

Continue in stocking stitch until desired height (dependent on your cup).

Change to 4.00mm needles.

1st row: (K2, P2) till end.

2nd row: (K2, P2) till end

Cast off.

Finishing:

Steam the piece to get it flat.

Using the felting kit, attach odds and ends of yarns to desired motif and design onto the piece, taking care to space them nicely.

Sew the piece into a tube using mattress stitch by joining sides.

*Tip: To change sizing for the cup, measure your cup and then using the tension guide on your yarn, cast on the required stitches. This of course means you can change the type of yarn you use too. The idea is to have fun and this project is perfect to use on that little odds and ends you have in your stash.
